Check-in – Hilton St. Pete Bayfront

For **check-in** times please refer to the daily schedules. Each finalist will receive a welcome packet upon arrival. Please <u>Provide</u> <u>Competitor # to the ADC|IBC Staff Member at Check-in</u>. This is the quickest way to receive your packet. (Tables are outside Grand Bay Ballroom)

Welcome Packets Include:

1. One Audition Number that corresponds with your competitor number. Audition number <u>must</u> be worn for: Technique Class Evaluation, Learn Compulsory Variation Class, Rehearsal for Compulsory Variation Class.

2. Anniversary Souvenir Booklet

3. An All Access Pass which needs to be worn to enter the Mahaffey Facility (both backstage & main lobby doors), and 20th Anniversary Brunch held at the Hilton.

4. 20th Anniversary Gala Ticket.

5. Gift from Sponsors.

VIP - Teacher Pass Holders:

<u>Best location</u> to pick-up Teacher Badges is at Check-in tables (Hilton). Packet will be under teacher name, <u>not</u> associated competitor name. If not picked up at Hilton on March 29 or 30, you may pickup at the Mahaffey starting March 31. Teacher packets will include the all-access pass which needs to be worn throughout the competition and the 20th Anniversary Brunch, (1) Gala Ticket, and a souvenir booklet. Teacher Pass Holders <u>**ONLY**</u>, may accompany participants in the wings during Open Stage. Teachers <u>**only**</u> have access inside the studio spaces. <u>Provided Badge will be required to be inside the Hilton ballrooms</u>.

VIP Passes are purchased through ADC IBC, not the Mahaffey Box Office. Teacher Badges have been pre-purchased online during registration. If you did not purchase in advance, you will be able to do so at the Check-in Tables. Parents of independent dancers, serving as their coach, may purchase the VIP Pass. For Purchases of VIP passes on site at the event, it is possible that the Brunch will be sold out, and only a teacher pass with access to the classes, competition, final round, and gala will be available for purchase.

Parent or Guest Tickets:

Are purchased directly through the Mahaffey Theater Box Office at the designated times seen on the 'Get Updated' Page. <u>Get Updated</u> <u>ADC IBC - Youth International Ballet Competition</u>. Tickets can also be purchased online at any time. Ticketmaster fees will apply for online sales. If you or a guest arrives late in the evening, and the Box Office is closed, you may purchase your ticket online. Your ticket will be emailed and live within minutes of purchase.

Parents are not permitted inside the Hilton Studio spaces, or the Mahaffey backstage (wings -only open for teacher pass holders.) Parent Passes have access to all daily competitive rounds in the Mahaffey Theater, Ruth Eckerd Hall, the Final Round, Gala and to accompany young students in the dressing rooms, if needed. <u>Please keep to a minimum</u>.

Parents & guests may purchase the discounted multi-day pass (which includes all rounds of competition plus the Final Round & Gala). Or you may purchase by the day. The Multi-day Pass does not include the 20th Anniversary Brunch (food service aspect). These tickets are sold separately, and was available to purchase during registration. Additional Brunch tickets may not be available to purchase on site, as headcounts have already been submitted to the Catering Team.

Ensemble Only Dancers:

You will not receive an audition number to wear in the "open master classes" unless you have submitted a scholarship form last month to be included in the Jury Book. These ensemble dancers will in fact have an audition number. Ensemble only dancers will NOT have individual packets prepared. <u>The teacher packet of the school with the ensemble</u> will include all access passes and Gala tickets for the 'ensemble only' students. The best time to pick up these packets is during check-in at the Hilton on March 29 & 30. Packets will be moved on March 31 to the Mahaffey Theater Lobby. The Ensemble only dancers pass has a RED lanyard, signifying that dancers have access to all competitive spaces at our venues, but <u>does not</u> include the Brunch (Food Service). This was a separate option for ensemble dancers to select during registration.

Ensemble only dancers are welcome to join in on their age "Open Master Classes". These classes begin on March 31. If there is availability in the classes, ensemble students are permitted to take both Group 1 & Group 2 classes of their age division, if they choose, while space permits.

Parking

Hilton: For Hilton Guests, parking fee includes overnight parking with in & out privileges. We recommend to stay parked and walk across the street to Mahaffey Theater.

Mahaffey: Day rate \$10. You will be able leave & come back without being charged multiple times if you keep your parking ticket. Does not include overnight parking.

Public City Parking: If you are not staying at the Hilton there is also Day Parking directly behind the Hilton (on 2nd Street), called 'AER' CAMDEN PUBLIC PARKING – for visitor parking.

NEW City Transportation

The city of St. Pete has just launched the SunRunner, that has stops from downtown St Pete all the way to the Beach. This is helpful for those of you that are staying at the Tru by Hilton Hotel on Central, and do not have a car. There's a stop by USF St Pete, which is by the Mahaffey Theater, or on 3rd Street. You can then take this to 13th Street (Tropicana Field) and walk couple blocks to 16th Street. Buses arrive every 15 min From 6am – 8pm. And every 30 minutes from 8pm – midnight. The digital screens at the stations let you know when the next bus is arriving.

You also have access to the Downtown Looper Trolly (the red trolley's you see) This trolly runs North to the Vinoy Hotel, for those staying there, and down Central as well. Ask your Hotel for the Trolly map.

Participant Attire:

Technique Class Evaluation / Learning Compulsory Work

- (Women) Black Leotard <u>Only</u>, Any Style. Pink/flesh-colored tights. Clean Bun.
- (Men) Black/Gray Tights, white t-shirt/leotard (cap or tank) Hair Neatly styled, no bandanas.
- Ballet shoes will be worn for technique class by all age divisions. (Senior ladies, please bring pointe shoes to technique class, jury may ask to see certain combinations en pointe, if time permits.)

- Primary Division Compulsory work will be given on demi-pointe. Teachers discretion for age 11 on whether dancer shall perform compulsory work en pointe. Age 10 and younger are to perform on demi-pointe.
- Junior & Senior Age Soloists will be required to Learn the Compulsory Classical Variation en pointe, unless received permission otherwise.
- Female soloists may wear their practice tutus/skirts in the 'Learn Compulsory Variation' Class.
- Audition number should be safety pinned (provided) in front, just under the chest

Classes are **mandatory. If you are **<u>not</u>** present, there will be a significant <u>point deduction</u>.

Rehearsal & Performance of Compulsory work – Round 1

- (Women) Black Leotard (Any Style), Practice tutu, pink/flesh colored tights, clean bun.
 *Practice tutu is not mandatory. If dancer chooses to do so: JR aged ladies, the variation selected will require a classical style, flat plate tutu. For Senior ladies, under knee/mid-calf length ballet skirt is recommended. For Primary age ladies, a romantic length tutu is recommended.
- (Men) Black or Gray Tights, white t-shirt/leotard (cap or tank) Hair Neatly styled, no bandanas

Prepared Dancer's Choice Performances – Round 2

• Prepared costumes for classical & contemporary solos.

Attire to Bring for Contemporary & Classical Repertoire featured in the 20th Anniversary Gala

Participants learn repertoire on site, audition, rehearse, and perform together in the Final Gala Performance on April 4. New this Year, dancers will have the opportunity to be selected to perform both styles of dance in the 2025 Gala. All Finalists, please bring the following with you to the competition, in the case you are selected to be a part of these pieces.

CONTEMPORARY

Females: White leotard. White tights. White socks.

Males: White or Light Gray Tights. White socks.

CLASSICAL

Females: White classical, flat plate practice tutu. White leotard. (For Paquita Rep). Applicable to JR & SR age. Junior will already be utilizing a classical tutu for their Compulsory variation. <u>Senior ladies, please make note to bring a classical style practice tutu along with your ballet skirt for compulsory.</u>

Males: Black Tights, white tee shirt.

Open Master Classes:

Open Master classes are an added learning opportunity the competition provides. These classes are not mandatory. DO NOT GET THESE CONFUSED WITH ROUND 1 CLASSES ON MARCH 29 & 30. THOSE ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL SOLOISTS. In the Open master classes dancers can wear any color leotards. Dancers should enter the classes that align with their age. Some ages we have classes designated for the specific groups. If the classes are not full, all students of that age may partake in the class. For example if you are a JR 1 student, you are to take JR 1 classes, and if the JR 2 class is not full, you may take those as well. Ensemble only students are eligible to take the Open Master Classes only.

Check-in at The Mahaffey:

Once you have entered the facility, there will be <u>no additional check-in</u>. Dancers can enter from the Main Lobby Doors, or the Backstage Entrance. (side facing the soccer stadium). It is preferred that dancers enter from the Backstage Entrance. <u>On Sunday March 30</u>, <u>Dancers are required to enter from Backstage Door</u>. And on the Final Day, <u>April 4</u>, <u>Participants dancing in the Gala are required to enter from Backstage Door</u>, as front entrances will be closed at certain times for preparation.

Section preparing to perform should be the only students backstage at that time. You will only need to <u>check-in with the backstage</u> <u>manager</u> during your open stage time. Any music irregularities or special instructions on stage entrance will need to be communicated with the backstage manager during open stage. Notify staff member whether you will enter *before or with the music*.

Music:

You will be required to have back-up Music for your entry numbers with you at the theatre, in the event we have technical difficulties. Backup options are by electronic device (ipod, USB flash drive). Devices with 3.5mm headphone jack or USB port will be accepted. You must create a specific playlist for your entries.

Dressing Rooms:

There are dressing rooms available backstage for competitors in the present category **ONLY**. Once you are finished performing, we will need you to move into the house to make room for later competitors. Before permitted to go backstage, we <u>recommend</u> getting your make-up/hair ready in your hotel. There is also numerous large restrooms front of house in the Mahaffey Theater Lobby.

When you are finished using the dressing rooms, please help us and clean up/wipe down your area!!!

Warm-up Space:

Our Home is a beautiful facility with ample space. There are plenty of areas to isolate yourself in the Mahaffey Lobby, the Atrium, the Mezzanine, or the Mezzanine level Ballroom.

There will be vendors plus the ADC IBC store in the Lobby for all your dancewear needs or memorabilia. Also, in the lobby, you will be able to view and purchase pictures/ video from Star Action Shots. There will be <u>no</u> personal flash photography or video allowed; professional services are provided.

Scores & Critiques:

Round 1 Compulsory Performance will not receive a video critique from the Jury. It is 1/5 of the Round 1 scoring rubric. You can read more about this in your program book at the event. Both Round 2 Prepared Solos will receive video judge critiques along with scores accessible through your dance comp genie account post event. Dancers who perform one last time in the Final Round, will not receive a video critique nor will scores populate in Dance Comp Genie. Final Round scores/ comments can be picked up at the ADC IBC tables in the Lobby, by competitor number.

Soloist Participants, VIP (teacher) Pass Holders, and other guests who have specifically purchased the Brunch are welcome to the Food Service.

*Ensemble Only students <u>who did not</u> purchase a brunch ticket, Parents or other guests <u>who did not</u> purchase a brunch ticket <u>will not be eligible for the Food Service.</u>

How to Enter Food Service: Entrance down by Grand Bay Ballroom. You will come to a table, like a hostess stand essentially. All Soloist Dancers & VIP's with their Event Pass will enter quickly.

*Those with a Red Lanyard or red dot on their VIP pass are not eligible for Food service.

Parents, Guests, or Ensemble dancers who have separately purchased a Brunch Ticket, will need to come to the table at the entrance. Your name will be on a list, and you will receive a wristband to signify that you have purchased a Brunch Ticket.

Once you gather your Meal, join us in the Grand Bay Ballroom to view the Seminars presented. Feel free to come and go and enjoy the party aspect of the event as well. Participants can dance to the live music, participate in our group photobooth with their friends, use props, and sign our Anniversary Guest Book!

Seminars: Start at 11am through 1PM. - ALL ARE WELCOME (see full seminar timeline on the Get Updated Page)

We are excited about our new collaborations to offer cutting-edge exercise science based talks to bring awareness to elite performers and to elevate their dance performance. Ruth Eckerd Hall Performances

There are select categories that will perform at this venue. There will be no ticketing at this location. All are welcome to view. This venue is approximately 30minutes away from the primary venues. Please plan accordingly with your open stage times. Parking is free at REH.Families that do not have a rental car, we recommend to take an uber /lyft to the location.

Scholarship Announcements:
